In 2020, she launched #LaCorteDice, an initiative that, in print and digital formats, democratizes the decisions of the Constitutional Court of Ecuador, thus promoting debate and understanding of national jurisprudence.

### Career

- Between 2013 and 2015 she studied a Master's Degree in Legal Sciences at Pompeu Fabra University and during that time she was able to collaborate with the NGO YMCA in the Voluntary Return Program where she worked together with migrant communities living in Spain.
- Upon her return to the country, Verónica taught Political Law at the Catholic University of Santiago de Guayaquil, where she was also able to be part of the Distance Learning Group Program "Persons Deprived of Liberty (PPL)", in which she was able to collaborate as a teacher. in the distance learning program in the Guayaquil men's prison. Then in 2016, she began as a full-time professor at the Espiritu Santo Specialty University where she taught Human Rights, Constitutional Law I, Constitutional Law II, Ethics and Legal Theory. Between 2015 and 2017, together with the then assemblywoman María Cristina Kronfle, she was a sponsor of the unconstitutionality action of the Disability Law Regulations that increased the percentage for the delivery of the Disability Card.
- In 2017 Verónica attended the Human Rights summer course at American University (Washington D.C.) where she focused on social rights issues.
- In 2018 Verónica went as a professional visitor to the Inter-American Court of Human Rights, where she was able to collaborate with Dr. Pablo Saavedra, Secretary of the International Court of Human Rights. In that same year, she was appointed as Academic Coordinator and later as Career Director of the Faculty of Law, Politics and Development, UEES. From that time to the present, Verónica carried out the UEES research project: "Study of sentences of extraordinary protection actions".
